Widener University Immunization Record and IGRA Blood Test Requirements

All NEW incoming Freshmen, International Undergraduate Students here one year or longer, and Transfer students are required to have the following immunizations and IGRA blood test.

You must upload the following to the specific sections on the Student Health Portal

- 1. <u>Tdap Booster</u> (Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis) <u>must be within the last 10 years</u>
- 2. <u>Meningitis A, C, Y, W-135</u> (Menactra, Menveo, or MenQuadfi) two doses are required, with one dose required at 16 years of age or older and the most recent dose within the last five years. Vaccine is required for students under the age of 23
- 3. <u>M.M.R.</u> (Measles, Mumps, and Rubella) two doses required at least 28 days apart for any students born after 1956 **OR** evidence of immunity with titer results uploaded to the portal.
- 4. <u>Varicella</u> (Chickenpox) two doses required **OR** evidence of immunity (*disease requires titer*) with titer results uploaded to the portal.
- 5. <u>Hepatitis B</u> two or three doses required depending on vaccine **OR** evidence of immunity with titer results attached and uploaded to the portal.
- 6. <u>IGRA Blood Test</u> (TB screening) IGRA testing is the only accepted Tuberculosis (TB) screening test. <u>PPD skin tests will not be accepted</u>. Either a QuantiFERON Gold or T-Spot will be accepted. IGRA blood test must be completed within one year prior to your start date. <u>Upload results with the date of collection and your full name to the portal.</u>
 - <u>First-time positive IGRA</u> result needs to be followed up with a Chest X-ray and evaluation by a Primary Care Provider or local Department of Health. X-ray report and medical documentation must be submitted
 - A history of latent or active Tuberculosis requires a Chest X-ray within the past year and documentation of treatment. X-ray report and treatment documentation must be submitted
